The mountain water is brown in colour (caused by organic plant material) and originates from the southern slope of the Riviersonderend mountains. It is believed to be the purest drinking water in this country.

There are many beautiful walks and hikes to take and nature lovers will delight in the breathtaking views across the valley.

Adventure seekers have exhilarating kloofing adventures to choose from - for the more extreme trips you will find yourself jumping off high rock faces into inky black pools.
