I would recommend trying some of the local "Patat-koek", a yummy cake-like pudding made out of sweet potatoes.

In summer the surrounding wheat fields are brown and the area looks rather arid, but in winter this Overberg region is in its full glory, with the fields illuminated in hues of green and yellow. With this beauty it is no wonder that so many city dwellers have made this town their weekend destination.
